



Storyboard Task

Instructions

- Use document 1 entitled 'camera shots and definitions' to match up the correct camera shot definition with the type of camera shot. You may need to do a little bit of research here to check whether they are correct.
- Use the documents 'storyboard task 1' & 'storyboard task 2' to have a go at learning how to frame these shots yourself. If you are social distancing, remember to only use people who live in the same household as you.
- You can use the camera on your mobile phone to do this. There are six shots to take for each task sheet and try to frame a shot that best matches what is required. You can add extra boxes if you wish to, as some scenes will require more than one shot.
- Paste the shots you have taken into the boxes next to the instructions and check they are correct. If you're not happy with any of them, retake the shot.
- Review your work. On media level 2 & 3 courses, evaluation is an important part of your future development. How did the task go? Did you understand all the shots and how to frame them? Which ones did you find tricky? What would you do differently next time?
