ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

We are committed to providing our students with value for money. We also like to encourage people with a range of experience and academic qualifications to apply for our courses.

We recommend that you check entry requirements for your chosen course, as course requirements do vary. We will typically require:

HND typically 48 tariff points

Honours Degree from 96 tariff points

Foundation Degree from 48 tariff points

For a HND or Honours Degree course including or equivalent to two A Levels or a BTEC National Diploma can be accepted. Direct entry is based on experience and employment.

OR a recognised equivalent qualification at level 3

AND GCSE maths and English **OR** GCSE English at level 2 or above
