Remaining up-to-date on relevant legislation concerning electrical equipment is essential. Like other construction professions, this role offers diverse opportunities to work on various projects. Electricians may be tasked with ensuring safe power supply to residential properties or contribute to large-scale construction and engineering projects as part of a team.

What areas will I study?

You will cover compulsory aspects such as: working safely and effectively, design, construct, test and commission electrical systems, methods of supervision, electrical science and principles, regulations and law, diagnose and repair electrical faults.

What are the entry requirements?

Maths and English grade must be a Minimum of GCSE 4/C or Functional skills at L2 in both subjects and must have Level 2 in Electrical Installation either 2365 L2 or 8202 L2

Where can I progress next?

The course provides a solid foundation for progression to Level 4 qualifications, an apprenticeship or into work.
