

**School Leavers:** For learners who are between the ages of 16 to 18, studies will be free.

**Adults:** For learners who are aged 19 or over, the cost of study will depend on the course or programme that you choose. Some courses may even be free\*. If the course is not free, students aged 19 at the start of their programme who wish to study need to either pay their course fees, or take out an Advanced Learning Loan.

\*Eligibility criteria applies. There may be an exception for students aged 19 or over that are taking their first full Level 3 qualifications (equivalent to A Levels and Access to HE Diplomas), who could be supported by the Learner Support Fund, or free adult course funded by the WMCA.
