1 Introduction

1.1 When using sccb.ac.uk, apply.sccb.ac.uk, bounrville.ac.uk, southandcity.com, alumni.sccb.ac.uk or sites containing these web addresses, we collect certain information or data about you.

2 What information do we collect?

- Name, Address, Date of Birth
- Email Address and Telephone number
- Preferences, Interests, Hobbies
- Information required for a course application
- Disability and any criminal convictions information
- Ethnicity information
- All the search terms using website search and course search
- IP address, browser type, operating system

3 How do we collect information?

- When you register with our website or apply for a course
- When you participate in surveys and promotions
- When you request information or subscribe to services (e.g. newsletters)
- Through web browser cookies
- Via third parties other websites such as Facebook, Google etc

4 What do we do with collected information?

- Respond to questions and requests
- Respond to feedback to improve our products and services
- Periodically send personalised promotional emails which may include businesses of third parties we think may be of interest to you
- We might contact you for market research purposes
- Customize the website to suit your interests

5 Controlling your personal information

5.1 The information provided might be used for the different purposes as explained above. However, please note that at the time of collection of information for particular purposes like promotional offers and marketing campaigns, an 'opt-out' option would be available depending on different circumstances. An opt-out option means you indicate that you do not want us to send any communication regarding various promotional offers and various other marketing campaigns and product information. If you have opted for the opt-out option, you may not be able to take advantage of all the features of the website.

6 What are cookies?

- 6.1 Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used to allow web applications to respond to you individually. This allows for websites to work more efficiently, as well as provide information to the owners of the site. The information the owners of the site receive, can be used to analyse website traffic. This helps the website owners make decisions on how to improve the website for its visitors.
- 6.2 Cookies can only store information that is shared by the website visitors. Cookies do not give the website access to other areas of your computer. Moreover, you are able to stop your browser from accepting cookies from websites. It should be noted that some browsers automatically accept cookies by default. Instructions on how to reconfigure your browser to stop accepting cookies will be in your browser's documentation.
